Welcome to the Global Green Alliance! With an aim to help groups and individuals achieve sustainable, successful change, individual membership is a new program launched by the GGA to help individuals take control of the positive impact they make on our environment.

With three distinct levels of bronze, silver, and gold, students can start from small actions to develop their skills and eventually move on to complete larger leadership projects.

To reward them for their actions, students will attend celebratory award presentations to receive certificates for their efforts and achievements from the President of their Provincial Board.

USING THIS BOOK

Members can use this book to track their progress. All members will start at the bronze level, and as they complete more hours of service, move onwards to further levels.

At the completion of the level, please scan your book with the advisor's signature and contact details to membership@ggainternational.org. At the next available awards ceremony, you will have your certificate awarded to you.

LEVELS

In order to complete a level, an individual must reach the total number of volunteer hours described (20 for bronze, 50 for silver, 100 for gold). The participant can choose their own events and activities, but must adhere to main goal of level and complete the required activities.

The prescribed activities follow a logical progression in leadership ability and time commitment, so as the individual grows and develops, the level accommodates. The goal of the Bronze level is action, the goal of the Silver level is participation, and the goal of the Gold level is leadership.

AWARDS

Awards are presented by the President of the member's provincial board at award ceremonies held every few months. Members will receive certificates for their levels achieved, as well as receive the other prizes designated for the level in the descriptions that follow.

ADVISORS

Advisors qualify as any adult that has witnessed the member partake in their listed activities and make a positive impact. The advisor may be contacted to verify the records given.
